




Safe Ensuite Integrated Basin (single outlet)

Installation instructions

Step 1: Safety first

These instructions relate to the use of the Safe Ensuite Integrated Basin (single outlet) only, any external or 'add-on' parts will be supplied with separate instructions.

It is recommended that the electrical part of the installation be carried out by a qualified electrician in accordance with the latest electrical regulations. It is also recommended that any plumbing is carried out by a qualified plumber.

IMPORTANT: Please read these instructions carefully and follow each stage in order!










Step 2 : Parts

Step 3: Wall Preparation & Drilling Template

Locating correct position


Please note - Maximum cable runs

Routing of cables back to the control box should be planned at this stage.


Temporarily fix the drilling template at the correct height using masking tape.

NOTE: As a guide, UK guidelines recommend a distance from the rim of the basin to the floor of between 780 and 800mm (standard use) / 720 and 740mm (disabled use). Use rim line on the drilling template.

Drill through the marked areas on the template. Remove the template, then secure the basin with the fixings as shown under step.4 and 5.





Step 4 : Fittings Installation



Step 5 : Sensor Installation

To fit sensor securely, tighten the 34" BSP backnut by hand as far as possible. Using a spanner tighten the backnut a further ½ turn.





Step 6: Cleaning

This product should be cleaned daily with warm soapy water, then rinsed with cold water. If desired, this product can be dried using a soft non-abrasive cloth.

The gel coat has a high gloss surface. Abrasive cleaners and scouring powders should be avoided, as long term, these products will scratch and damage the gel coat.

Non abrasive cleaning agents can be used, however, we recommend testing the product in an inconspicuous area first to ensure compatibility- checking there is no deterioration in the surface quality. Any cleaning products should be used as per the manufacturers instructions.

If bleach is used to sanitise the product, it is important to rinse it away with a copious amount of water. Bleach should not be left in contact with the product for a long period of time.

Care should be taken to avoid contact with the following chemicals as they can damage the gel coat; paint strippers, strong disinfectants, alcohol, aftershave, perfumes, nail varnishes and their removers.
