Royal Cornhill Hospital is the main centre in the North East of Scotland for the care and treatment of people with mental health problems. This is also the main training centre for medical and nursing staff working in mental health. The hospital is located close to the centre of Aberdeen and provides in-patient, outpatient and day patient care.

Having recently refurbished Huntly Ward with DVS Safe En-Suite products, work is now underway to upgrade Fraser Ward. Following a report from The Mental Welfare Commission for Scotland (MWCS) NHS Grampian said, "We welcome the commission's praise of the work we have done to upgrade Huntly ward. This work will be repeated across our adult inpatient wards and will greatly improve the environment for patients, their families and our staff"

The Fraser ward is the second ward that DVS have been specified for as part of a multi-million pound improvement scheme that is set to lower risks to patients.

The next project phases will include Dunnotar & Fyvie wards.

Fraser Ward is a refurbishment of 18 rooms comprising of Safe En-Suite furniture including blue top WC pans, high security integrated basins & showers, ligature resistant hooks and isolating key switches.
