Sowenna CAMHS Unit

Cornwall's first child and adolescent mental health services (CAMHS) unit has now officially opened in Bodmin.

Sowenna is an NHS unit run by Cornwall NHS Foundation Trust. The new £11 million; 14-bed site provides inpatient treatment for young people aged between 13-18 from across the southwest. It has been specially designed to offer an environment where young people may be assessed and treated for mental health problems, in a modern friendly setting.

Dart Valley Systems have worked closely with the Trust, consultants and main contractor to delivery a specialist user friendly washroom facility.

Before completion, the Dart Valley team commissioned the site, to make sure that all settings were correct for each individual area, so all bedrooms could welcome its first arrivals on time.
